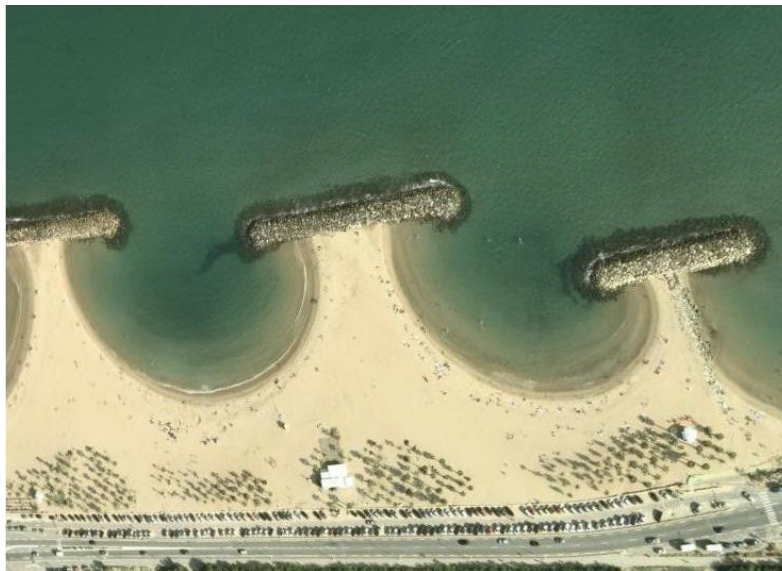

What is an emergent breakwater?

A wall of rocks that rises 1 to 3 feet out of the water. They are placed a few hundred feet off the beach and designed to absorb the energy of the waves that hit it, eliminating breaking waves and thereby slowing beach erosion. (photo below.)
